	The requirement for 5+1 pathway candidates to sit the National Psychology Exam (NPE) seems increasingly misaligned with the structure and rigor of this training route. The 5+1 model includes a year of postgraduate study with coursework and placement, followed by a supervised practice year involving 1,500 hours of work, including 500 hours of client contact. This provides a strong blend of academic and practical experience. In contrast, the second year of higher degree programs typically involves less coursework and more placement (still less than, almost half of what 5+1 intern would undergo), with coursework focussed on endorsement pathways. The difference in academic content does not necessarily justify the additional burden of

of the NPE on 5+1 candidates, especially as both pathways lead to general registration. If the NPE is considered essential for assessing core competencies, it would be more equitable to extend it to all general registration pathways, including higher degree programs. Alternatively, the NPE content should be revised to reflect only the core coursework relevant to generalist practice, rather than compensating for perceived gaps that may not exist.

I supervise registrars, 5+1 Interns and provisional psychologists under the AWOP-76 pathway (working in addition to university placements for Provisional Psychologists as approved by the Board). The removal of six-monthly progress reports is presented as a step toward reducing regulatory burden. However, it is unclear how this objective is achieved when the same reporting requirement remains for other provisional psychologists (e.g., those practicing under AWOP-76). This inconsistency contradicts the stated goal of reducing regulatory burden. Reporting requirements should be consistent for all provisionally registered psychologists who practice pursuant to Provisional registration standard. If six-monthly reporting is no longer necessary, then the PPSR-76 requirement should similarly be removed. If the requirement to submit the PPSR-76 is retained, then the proposed removal of six-monthly reporting for other Provisionals should not proceed. Maintaining this requirement for AWOP-76 Provisionals, while removing it for others, introduces inconsistency into the regulatory framework. All Provisional Psychologists can only practice under supervision. Streamlining the guidelines and ensuring consistency across all Provisionals from 1 December 2025 will more accurately reflect the Board's effort to reduce unnecessary regulatory burden and reflect the commitment to greater flexibility to the supervisory process.

Their removal risks impacting client outcomes and service quality. In addition, the proposed change to have logbooks reviewed only by supervisors, rather than submitted to the Board or an independent body, raises concerns about consistency, accountability, and transparency. An objective third-party review is important to ensure that standards are applied fair uniformly across different settings. Finally, while addressing workforce shortages is vital, the focus should be on training psychologists who are adequately prepared—not just increasing numbers. Remove dependency on AHPRA approval before a provisional can start to see clients if they already have an agreed board approved supervisor who is ready for them to start seeing clients, and if they have submitted their internship application. Not being able to start employed work as a provisional psychologist for months due to the period of time it takes for AHPRA approval is a disservice to the unmet need for mental health support, and financially punishes provisional psychologists. Rather than requiring questions to be answered on the internship form, it would be more efficient to provide statemetrs or declarations to be jointly signed by supervisors, employers and prov psychs to remove the back and forth over how to phrase certain responses to get approval. Provide a deadline by which applications for internships MUST be assessed. Waiting for months with no certainty of timeframe is not helpful, and there needs to be a transparent process for expediting approvals. Remove all unecessary reporting or provide better clarification of requirements alogn with clear examples of documents / outputs that meet requirements. eg. logbooks. No example is provided for what a completed logbook should look like and the level of data required. A digital solution would be more appropriate. Review all regulations that might unecessarily and inadvertently financially punish or constrain / delay a prov psych's ability to start a paid roles / earn while doing their internship.

There needs to be a mroe realisitic assessment of whether the guidelines enable a prov psych to meet requirements for full registration within 12 months of completing thier matsers, especially if they have to first wait months to find a suitable internship role + approval of the internship. Any changes that make it more possible for these requirements to be met within that time period would be very welcome. Explore opportunities to further shorten the time between a prov psych being offered a role, and that role being approved as part of an internship. Make it possible for job descriptions to be submitted early to AHPRA for approval at the time the job is applied for, so that by the time there is a job offer with a start date, the prov psych isn't being held back from starting a job because of the lack of AHPRA approval in time. This impacts clients, employers, and prov psychs. Alternatively, allow supervisor approval / agreement to be sufficient so that an internship application is one that registers the internship rather than one that is awaiting approval. It's not clear what benefit additional AHPRA approval provides over and above primary supervisor approval. The draft guidelines state under section 3.7 "While there is no maximum timeframe for completion, applicants must meet the requirements of the Recency of Practice standard." However, the consultation paper states that there is no change to the maximum time frame to complete. I am fully in support of the wording in the draft guidelines, and believe this change would support those conducting the internship with competing needs, and those from diverse groups. In terms of recency of practice, the draft guides state that "To commence the internship after having a substantial break in practice (i.e., more than three years) since completing their fifth-year postgraduate study, applicants must refer to the Board's Recency of Practice policy.", while the policy states "To meet recency meet the recency of practice requirements you must demonstrate successful completion ofa Board-approved program of study within the past five years". I propose the substantial break in practice is more than five years, for consistency.

I cannot emphasise enough how much I support these proposed changes. There is a substantial administrative and practical burden on provisional psychologists to complete internship activities (such as case studies) outside of their working hours, which directly leads to extended delays to provisional psychologists' ability to apply for general registration and to contribute to the growth of the profession. These outdated requirements (e.g., case studies) don't reflect the skills and practical requirements of the psychology profession, and negatively impact on the industry generally due to delays to full registration status and substantial unnecessary supervisor workload. In relation to maintaining provisional registration status for those undertaking the 5+1, it would be good to be more specific about registration status between completion of the 5th year study (e.g., MPP), but before commencing an approved internship. For example, individuals can take a break and maintain provisional registration status in this period of time, but we (of course) may not practise until supervised practice arrangements have been approved by the Board. This should be outlined clearly and reflected in the provisional registration renewal form. Thank you for your hard work in suggesting these fantastic and practical changes to the 5+1 guidelines.

Case studies are one of the most important ways for supervisees not only to demonstrate competency but to learn competency. By working through and presenting each of the case study requirements, supervisees learn what is required when providing an evidence-based assessment and intervention. They also learn how to write a sound clinical report. A better proposal would be that supervisees complete two case studies, one assessment and one intervention, according to the current Board requirements, but rather than submitting them to AHPRA for marking, the principal supervisor assesses whether they meet requirements. This approach is already used in many of the accredited 6th year courses, such as the Master of Clinical Psychology – Advanced Entry, where placement supervisors assess the case studies completed by their supervisees. The Board's mandated supervisor training could then include useful, specific training on how to assess these case studies, rather than the very generic material that is often presented. This also creates appropriate separation of power and responsibilities: AHPRA/PsyBA become the regulators which is their appropriate role, rather than the trainers/pseudo-supervisors, as they are currently when they get involved in marking and providing feedback on case studies. This is a good idea!
