Introduction/ Purpose

Thank you for your interest in being appointed an Examiner for the Chinese medicine Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) for internationally qualified Chinese medicine practitioners.

Examiner skills and eligibility

The following points are the **essential** examiner skills and eligibility criteria:

 Current, unrestricted registration with the Chinese Medicine Board of Australia (the Board) in the divisions of acupuncture and Chinese herbal medicine

and

- 2. relevant academic qualification in Chinese Medicine.
- 3. Chinese medicine clinical practice experience and/or Chinese medicine practice supervision experience, within Australia for a minimum of five (5) or more, years with demonstrated knowledge of and ability to, apply Chinese Medicine standards, codes and guidelines.
- 4. Sound understanding of the professional capabilities for Chinese medicine practitioners (the professional capabilities)
- 5. Current Chinese medicine practice and/or Chinese medicine practice supervision role.
- 6. Ability to attend examinations held in Melbourne but which may be held online or in other states and territory capital cities
- 7. Currently hold or can obtain Working with Children Check Victoria.

The following are desirable but not essential examiner skills and eligibility criteria:

 Relevant experience in a training and/or education environment e.g, training and supervision, and management/oversight of health practitioners in a clinical or educational setting and/or via the OSCE modality.

Remuneration / Travel & Accommodation

Examiners will be remunerated for their time.

For examiners from interstate (based outside of Melbourne), travel and accommodation expenses will be covered.
