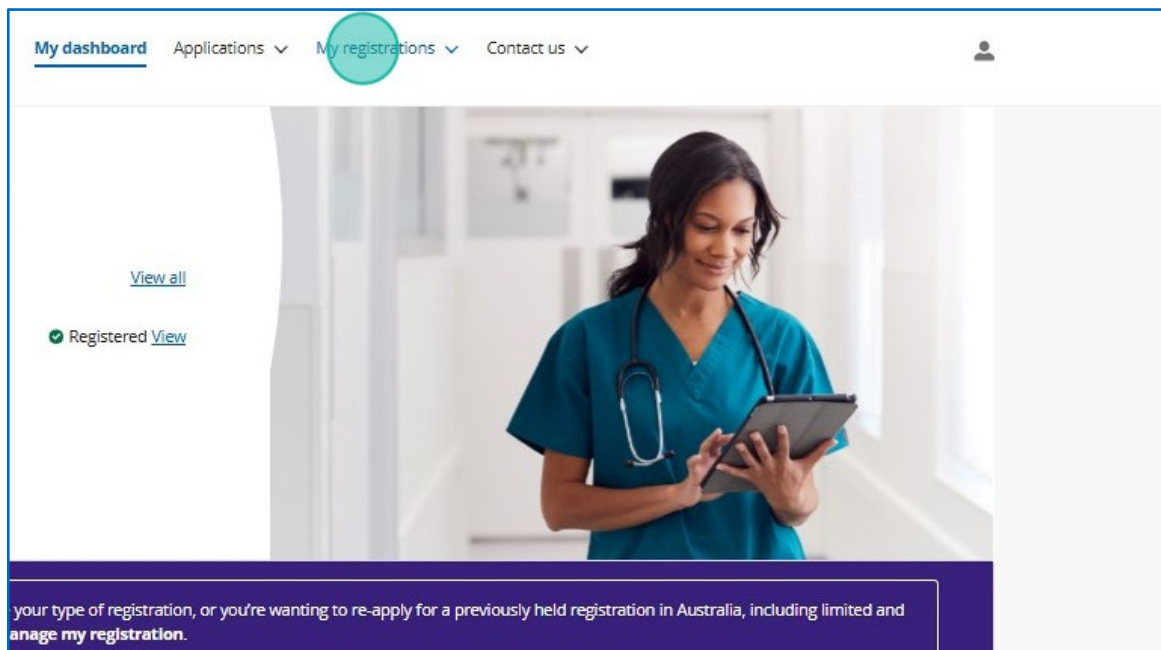

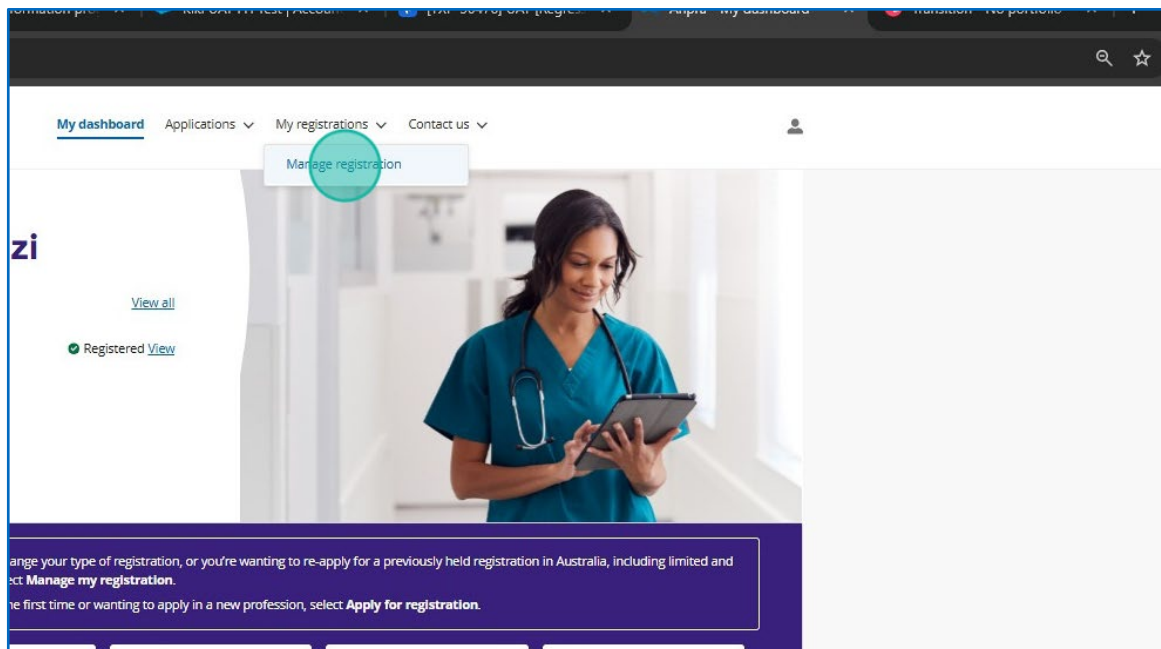

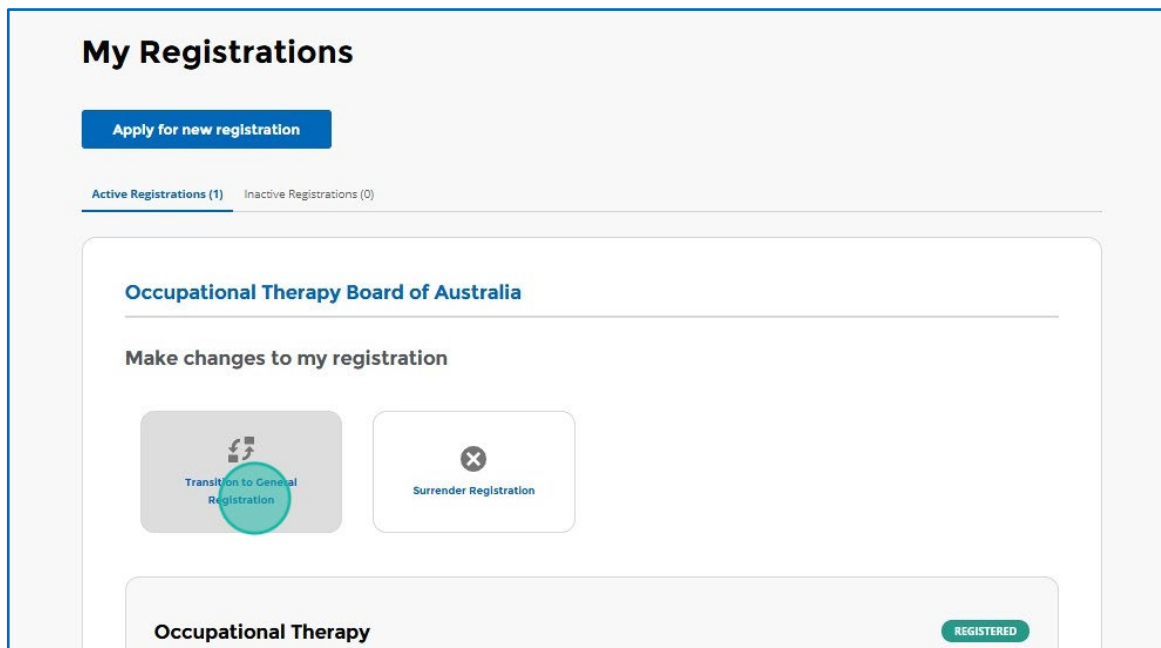

The form will guide you on the questions and sections required to be completed. Please carefully review the information you supply to ensure it is complete and accurate.

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

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
