Committee meeting

The 69th meeting of the Committee was held on 12 June 2025 via videoconference.

Accreditation assessments and monitoring activities

Routine monitoring

The Committee considered a further information response in relation to the 2024 Routine monitoring report from an education provider and their two programs of study.

Notice of change

The Committee considered a notice of change from one education provider and their three programs of study.

The Committee will provide updates to the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia (Board) on its monitoring of programs of study after the meeting.

Discussion items

2019 Accreditation standards: Medical radiation practice review

The review of the 2019 *Accreditation standards: Medical radiation practice* project commenced in March 2024. The project is being conducted in conjunction with the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Practice, Chinese Medicine and Podiatry Accreditation Committees. Public consultation on the draft standards is open until 25 June 2025. Health Professions Accreditation Collaborative Forum

The Committee discussed the significance of interprofessional education (IPE) and acknowledged the ongoing work of the Health Professions Accreditation Collaborative Forum (HPACF) working group in promoting collaboration among all accreditation authorities. The Committee also noted the IPE Colloquium hosted by the Australian Pharmacy Council on 13 May 2025, which focused on the theme of trust.

Stakeholder relationships/partnerships

At the June 2025 meeting, the Committee met separately with the following organisations: Australian and New Zealand Society of Nuclear Medicine (ANZSNM) and Medical Radiations Australia (MRA) representatives to discuss topics of relevant interests such as the work of their organisations and the Committee.

ANZSNM and MRA and the Committee agreed to continue to engage on a regular basis on issues important to medical radiation practice programs.
