The current RACGP CME scheme is already ensuring we stay up to date and reflect on our practice including performing clinical audits.

Why burden us with another 50 hours of unpaid bureaucracy?

Do you have any idea how low morale is in general practice?

Do you realise GP training places remain unfilled as younger doctors vote with their feet and choose specialising over GP?
