I do not believe that even working full time, they have gained enough experience to competently assess a patient then utilise the knowledge from that assessment to prescribe. Moreover, they are not able to adequately assess the effect of the drugs they prescribe. For example, I work in PACU. I see less experienced RNs (<4th year) continue to give the same drug for pain relief which is not effective, rather than consider prescribed adjuvants, drugs to reduce tolerance or switch to/ seek prescription for an alternative drug. I feel that they need more time working in the one area, to gain experience to enhance their knowledge before they should be allowed to prescribe.
