Introduction

The role of the Pharmacy Board of Australia (the Board) includes:

- registering pharmacists and students
- developing standards, codes and guidelines for the pharmacy profession
- handling notifications, complaints, investigations and disciplinary hearings
- overseeing the assessment of overseas trained pharmacists who wish to practise in Australia, and
- approving accreditation standards and accredited courses of study.

The Board's functions are supported by the <u>Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency</u> (Ahpra). For information about legislation governing our operations see <u>About Ahpra</u> at <u>www.ahpra.gov.au/About-Ahpra/What-We-Do/Legislation.aspx</u>.

The Board has analysed its registration data and produced a number of statistical breakdowns about registrants to share with the profession and community. The Board shares these breakdowns regularly.

In April 2020, Ahpra and National Boards established a temporary pandemic response sub-register for up to 12 months to help fast track the return to the workforce of experienced and qualified health practitioners to assist during the COVID-19 pandemic. In early April 2021, the Commonwealth Health Minister requested that pharmacists (as well as nurses, midwives and medical practitioners and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health practitioners) be extended to stay on the sub-register for up to 12 months to help with the COVID-19 vaccination program only. 

Table 1.2 Registration type by principal place of practice percentages




