Introduction


The Expedited Specialist pathway is for specialist international medical graduates (SIMGs) with an international specialist medical qualification on the Medical Board's *Expedited Specialist pathway: accepted qualifications list.* The Expedited Specialist pathway is open for general practice, anaesthetics, psychiatry, and obstetrics and gynaecology. This monthly report provides information on the progress with Expedited Specialist pathway applications and registrations.


Applications

As of 28 April 2025:


- 251 internationally qualified specialists have applied for registration in Australia since the pathway opened
- Of these, **223** applications were for general practice, **13** applications for anaesthetics, **13** applications for psychiatry and **2** applications for obstetrics and gynaecology
- 127 applicants have been registered 125 GPs, 1 anaesthetist and 1 psychiatrist
- 84% of applicants are from the United Kingdom.














Figure 3 - Total registrations by specialty
