



February 2023 Chinese Medicine Accreditation Committee meeting

Committee meeting

The 50th meeting of the Committee was held via Zoom on 9 February 2023. The Committee anticipates holding two more meetings in 2023.

Some activities that were discussed at the Committee's February 2023 meeting, as well as some other activities, are outlined below.

Assessments and monitoring activities

Accreditation assessments

The Committee noted the status of two accreditation assessments currently underway and anticipates receiving accreditation assessment applications from two education providers for four programs.

Monitoring approved programs of study

The Committee considered monitoring responses from two education providers and their programs of study. The outcomes of the Committee's evaluations will be provided to the education providers and the Chinese Medicine Board of Australia (National Board) in February 2023.

The Committee will continue to provide updates to the National Board on its monitoring of approved programs of study.

2023 routine annual monitoring

The Committee approved the 2023 routine annual monitoring report and associated templates (2023 RAM package) at their December 2022 meeting. The 2023 RAM package will be disseminated to education providers in April 2023.

2022 routine annual monitoring

The Committee considered the assessors' evaluation of the information submitted by two education providers for their 2022 routine annual monitoring reports. The outcomes of the Committee's evaluation will be provided to the education providers and National Board in March 2023.

Stakeholder engagement

The Program Accreditation team, on behalf of the Committee, continues to engage with education providers via the Committee's [accreditation webpages](#); through correspondence via email, phone contact and videoconference meetings, and communiques.
