#### Transition to a new registration type under the National Law

The national registration and accreditation scheme will begin on 1 July 2010 in each State and Territory that has enacted the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act 2009* ('the National Law').

The types of registration available under the National Law are:

- · General registration
- Specialist registration
  - o 13 specialities in dentistry
  - o 23 specialities in medicine
  - o 1 speciality in podiatry
- Limited registration
  - o Postgraduate training or supervised practice
  - Area of need
  - o Teaching or research
  - o In the public interest
- Provisional registration
- · Non-practising registration, and
- Student registration.

Not all registration types are used in every profession.

Endorsement of registration is also used to identify those practitioners with additional qualifications and specific expertise. Endorsements available are:

- Scheduled medicines
- Nurse practitioner
- Midwife practitioner
- · Acupuncture, and
- Area of practice.

The attached tables show how current registrants in each State or Territory transition to new registration types, and in some cases to endorsements.
