# Community Reference Group Communiqué

The Community Reference Group (CRG) met at the AHPRA National office in Melbourne on Tuesday 9 May 2017.

#### **AHPRA** update

AHPRA CEO, Martin Fletcher, noted:

- the Medical Board of Australia and AHPRA had accepted all recommendations in the report, Independent review of the use of chaperones to protect patients in Australia, released in April 2017
- the Senate inquiry, <u>Complaints mechanism administered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law</u>, was due to report the next day
- National Boards and AHPRA had filed a written submission as part of the Accreditation Systems Review public consultation conducted through February—April 2017, and
- applications were now open for the inaugural Paramedicine Board of Australia and some State and Territory Boards of the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme.

### Regulatory operations

Members were updated on ongoing work on notifications projects and asked for feedback on online and written materials.

#### Advertising compliance

Members were notifed that the *Advertising compliance and enforcement strategy* for the National Scheme had been <u>published online</u>. Members provided advice on further work on advertising compliance.

## **Amendments to the National Law**

Members provided advice on potential amendments to the National Law, currently in consultation

#### Meeting with the Chirpopractic Board of Australia

Chiropractic Board of Australia Chair, Wayne Minter and community member, Anne Burgess, sought CRG members' advice on engaging with the community.
