

## Supervision report template

Supervision reports, completed by the supervisor in consultation with the supervisee, are to be submitted to the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency for consideration by the Podiatry Board of Australia ("the Board"):

- as stipulated by the Board on approval of a supervised practice plan as required by the Board
- to propose or justify changes in supervision, including level of supervision

□ Returning to practice after an absence of greater than three years

Hold a type of limited registration where supervision is a requirement of registration.

Significant change to scope of practice
