Eligibility requirements for AHPRA Agency Management Committee (AManC) Chair and members

Specific eligibility requirements - AManC member with expertise in health, education and training

You are eligible to seek appointment if you have expertise in health, education and training.

In your cover letter, you may wish to confirm this requirement is met and identify whether your expertise is in:

- o health, or
- o education and training, or
- o both.

Specific eligibility requirements – AManC member with expertise in health and/or business administration

You are eligible to seek appointment if you:

- **are not** a current or previously registered health practitioner (ie, under the current National Law, or a former state or territory registration Act); and
- you have expertise in health and/or business administration.

In your cover letter, you may wish to confirm these requirements are met, and identify whether your expertise is in:

- o health or
- o business administration, or
- o both.

Specific eligibility requirements - Chair, AManC

You are eligible to seek appointment as Chair, AManC if you are not a registered health practitioner and have not been a health practitioner in the last 5 years.

Eligibility requirements for ALL persons seeking appointment

- In deciding whether to appoint a person, the Ministerial Council will have regard to the skills and expertise of the person, as relevant to the exercise of the functions of the Agency Management Committee.
- A person is not eligible for appointment if he/she has, at any time, been found guilty of an offence that, in the opinion of the Ministerial Council, renders the person unfit to hold the office of member.
- A person appointed to a National Board is not eligible to serve as a member of the AHPRA Agency Management Committee.
