

## Return to practice checklist

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If you are applying for registration and do not meet the requirements of the Recency of practice registration standard you should provide the following information to the Board<sup>1</sup>.

*You can tick off the list/s below to guide you through the documents that you need to provide to the Board and refer to for additional information.*

- Relevant application form – a list of forms is on the [Registration page](#) of the Board's website.
- A professional development plan.
- A supervised practice plan and supervision agreement (where required) – signed by all relevant individuals.

To assist you to complete the above you should review the following documents from the Board's website:

- Recency of practice registration standard
- FAQ: Recency of practice
- Information sheet: Returning to practice or significantly changing scope of practice
- Continuing professional development registration standard
- Supervised practice plan – template
- Professional development plan – template
- Supervision agreement – template
