The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Practice, Chinese Medicine and Medical Radiation Practice Accreditation Committees (Accreditation Committees) have published a consultation paper on their draft revised accreditation standards. Public consultation began last week on 29 August and will close on 15 October 2018.

The Accreditation Committees are undertaking a joint review of their current accreditation standards. Accreditation standards are used to assess whether a program of study (and the education provider delivering the program) provide graduates with the knowledge, skills and professional attributes necessary to practise the profession competently and safely in Australia.

How to provide feedback

The Accreditation Committees hope to receive the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency's feedback on the draft revised accreditation standards. You may wish to provide feedback on the draft revised accreditation standards for any or all of the professions.
