The CoAG Health Council policy direction includes the need to consult with patient safety bodies and health consumer bodies to ensure AHPRA and the National Boards ask for advice as required. However, the draft revised regulatory principals only briefly refer to the need to consult with relevant bodies. The ADOHTA, therefore, recommends further

emphasis is placed within the regulatory principals on the consultation of patient safety bodies and health consumer bodies.
