Sets endorsement eligibility requirements

Developed by MBA Includes public consultation

Approved by Health Ministers

AMC Accreditation standards for cosmetic surgery programs

Sets standards for accreditation of cosmetic surgery programs

Developed by AMC and Project Advisory Group (RACS, plastic surgeons, cosmetic practitioners, related disciplines, educators, consumers) Includes public consultation

AMC Graduate outcomes/capability statements

Sets the knowledge, skills and professional behaviour requirements for graduates of accredited cosmetic surgery programs

Becomes part of the accreditation standards

Developed by AMC and Technical Advisory Group (medical educationalists, surgical educators and clinicians, and members with education and training expertise from related disciplines)

Includes public consultation

Approved by MBA

Cosmetic surgery education providers

Apply to AMC to have cosmetic surgery program accredited

AMC assesses programs against accreditation standards

AMC grants accreditation to programs that meet standards

MBA approves and publishes list of approved programs

Doctors seeking endorsement

Graduates of approved cosmetic surgery programs* apply to MBA for endorsement

MBA grants endorsement to doctors with approved qualification who meet registration standard*

Endorsement published on the public register

*The AMC will set the date from which each cosmetic surgery program is accredited. Graduates with qualifications from that date will be eligible for endorsement.
